## POKERRULES

## Actions:

- Fold: throwing away your hole cards and exiting the hand.
- Call: matching the current bet without adding more chips.
- Raise: increasing the current bet by putting more chips in the pot.
- Check: transferring the action to the next player without committing any chips to the pot.
- **Bet:** putting chips into the pot at any time in the hand. It usually refers to postflop action.
- All-in: a specific bet, meaning you are putting all your chips in the pot.



## Types of Poker Games:

Poker comes in many forms, but most fall into three categories: Community Card, Stud and Draw games. Here are the most popular types you might encounter:

- **Texas Hold'em:** each player gets two hole cards, and up to five community cards are dealt face up.
- Omaha: each player receives four hole cards, but must use exactly two of them and three community cards to make a hand.
- **Big O:** a variation of Omaha where players receive five hole cards instead of four, still using exactly two of them and three community cards.
- Seven-Card Stud: no community cards are used. Each player is dealt seven cards, three face down and four face up, with multiple betting rounds as cards are revealed.
- Five-Card Stud: each player receives one card face down and four face up, with a betting round after each new card.
- Short Deck (6+) Hold'em: played just like Texas Hold'em but with a 36-card deck, changing some hand rankings.
- Five-Card Draw: each player is dealt five private cards, followed by one round where they can discard and draw new cards to improve their hand.
- Razz: a lowball stud variant where the goal is to make the lowest possible five-card hand.
- Badugi: a unique draw poker game using four cards where players aim to make the lowest hand with all different suits and ranks.
